- (C) A member of the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration Commissioned Officer Corps; or
- (D) A member of the active or reserve component of the United States Commissioned Corps of the Public Health Service; and"

Page 2, line 29, delete "an active duty" and substitute "a"

Page 2, delete line 30, and substitute the following: "services;

- SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 6-41-902, concerning student eligibility under the Succeed Scholarship Program, is amended to add an additional subsection to read as follows:
- (e) An eligible student who is a child of a member of the uniformed services may receive a scholarship under this subchapter only if funds remain after all eligible students as described by subdivisions (a)(2)(A)-(D) of this section have received a scholarship under this subchapter."
