Amendment No. 1 to House Bill 1462

Amend House Bill No. 1462 as originally introduced:

- Page 2, delete lines 1 through 7, and substitute the following:

 "of the staff of the institution of higher education to serve as the liaison for students who are homeless, in foster care, or who left foster care at eighteen (18) years of age or older if the institution of higher education determines that there is a need for a liaison for students who are homeless, in foster care, or who left foster care at eighteen (18) years of age or older.
- (c) A liaison for students who are homeless, in foster care, or who left foster care at eighteen (18) years of age or older under subsection (b) of this section shall:
- (1) Inform prospective and current students of the institution of higher education who are homeless, in foster care, or who left foster care at eighteen (18) years of age or older about:"

AND

- Page 2, delete lines 10 through 13, and substitute the following:
 "students of the institution of higher education who are homeless, in foster care, or who left foster care at eighteen (18) years of age or older; and
- (2) Assist students of the institution of higher education who are homeless, in foster care, or who left foster care at eighteen (18) years of age or older in applying for and receiving:
 - (A) Federal and state financial aid; and
- (B) Other available services designed to assist students who are homeless, in foster care, or who left foster care at eighteen (18) years of age or older with navigating and successfully managing course work and student life."
