Amendment No. 3 to House Bill 1469

Amend House Bill No. 1469 as engrossed H3/3/21 (version: 03/03/2021 9:39:25 AM):

Page 2, line 22, delete "tax records and other" and substitute "nonconfidential aggregate and statistical"

AND

Page 2, line 24, delete "documents and other"

AND

Page 2, delete lines 28 through 32, and substitute the following:

"(2)(A) The Secretary of the Department of Finance and Administration shall provide the Bureau of Legislative Research with direct access to nonconfidential aggregate and statistical information derived from state tax collection and administration records for use in state budgeting and forecasting and the preparation of fiscal impact statements on proposed legislation.

(B) The information disclosed under subdivision (k)(2)(A) of this section shall not contain:

(i) Personally identifiable or confidential taxpayer information, including without limitation a taxpayer's:

- (a) Name;
- (b) Address;
- (c) Date of birth;
- (d) Taxpayer identification number;



- (e) Social security number;
- (f) Driver's license number;
- (g) Vehicle identification number;
- (h) License plate number;
- (i) Telephone number;
- (j) E-mail address; or
- (k) Financial institution information;
- (ii) Tax return, audit report, or information or

documents pertaining to a tax return or audit report;

(iii) Federal tax information, including without

limitation:

(a) A return as defined under 26 U.S.C. § 6103(b)(1), as it existed on January 1, 2021;

(b) Return information as defined under 26

U.S.C. § 6103(b)(2), as it existed on January 1, 2021; and

(c) Taxpayer return information as defined

under 26 U.S.C. § 6103(b)(3), as it existed on January 1, 2021; or (iv) Any information or document determined to be confidential by the secretary under state or federal law."

AND

Immediately following SECTION 2, add an additional section to read as follows:

"SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE. Sections 1 and 2 of this act are effective on and after January 1, 2022."
