Amendment No. 2 to House Bill 1789

Amend House Bill No. 1789 as engrossed H3/30/21 (version: 03/30/2021 10:19:10 AM):

Page 4, delete line 4, and substitute the following: "the permission request on file. (f)(1)(A) A federal law enforcement agency may enter into an agreement with a county sheriff that results in a memorandum of understanding between the federal law enforcement agency and the county sheriff instead of obtaining the required written permission as described in subsection (e) of this section. (B) For a memorandum of understanding to be valid, notification must be given prior to an arrest, a search, or a seizure instead of obtaining the required written permission as described in subsection (e) of this section. (2) A copy of the signed memorandum of understanding shall be kept on file at the county sheriff's office and with the Attorney General. (3) A memorandum of understanding under this subsection expires at the end of each term served by a county sheriff. (4) Failure to notify the county sheriff under this section and

as required by a memorandum of understanding immediately voids the memorandum of understanding."
