(b) The written transcript: (1) Shall be redacted as necessary to shield from disclosure any information that qualifies for an exemption under either § 25-19-105(b) or a law that specifically provides for the nondisclosure of certain information; and (2) Is subject to disclosure in response to a request for public records. (c) The municipality shall publish the written transcript in a local newspaper within sixty (60) calendar days of the executive session."
