TO REGULATE THE AUDIO RECORDING AND PERMITTED ATTENDEES AT CERTAIN EXECUTIVE
SESSIONS HELD BY MUNICIPALITIES; AND TO REQUIRE MUNICIPALITIES TO REIMBURSE
PLAINTIFFS UNDER CERTAIN CONDITIONS.

Amendment No. 1 to House Bill 1872

Amend House Bill No. 1872 as originally introduced:

Page 1, delete lines 11 through 12, and substitute the following:
"PROVIDE FOR THE"

AND

Delete the subtitle in its entirety and substitute:

"TO REGULATE THE AUDIO RECORDING AT
CERTAIN EXECUTIVE SESSIONS HELD BY
MUNICIPALITIES; AND TO REQUIRE
MUNICIPALITIES TO REIMBURSE PLAINTIFFS
UNDER CERTAIN CONDITIONS."

AND

Page 2, delete lines 17 through 20, and substitute the following:
"executive session shall:"

AND

Page 2, line 21, delete "(ii)(a) Shall make" and substitute "(i)(a) Make"

AND

Page 2, line 23, delete "one (1) year" and substitute "three (3) years"

AND

Page 2, line 27, delete "; and" and substitute ";"



Page 2, line 28, delete "(iii) Shall, at" and substitute "(ii) At"

AND

Page 2, line 30, delete "meeting." and substitute the following:

"meeting; and

(iii)(a) Within thirty (30) calendar days of the executive session, prepare a written transcript of the executive session.

(b) The written transcript:

(1) Shall be redacted as necessary to shield from disclosure any information that qualifies for an exemption under either § 25-19-105(b) or a law that specifically provides for the nondisclosure of certain information; and

(2) Is subject to disclosure in response to a request for public records.

(c) The municipality shall publish the written transcript in a local newspaper within sixty (60) calendar days of the executive session."
