Page 1, delete lines 29 through 32, and substitute the following:
 "(10)(A) "Meeting" means a discussion among three (3) or more
members of a governing body about a matter relating to public business on
which it is reasonably foreseeable that the governing body may take action.
 (B) "Meeting" includes without limitation:
 (i) Discussions in person, by telephone,
electronically, or by other means of communication; and
 (ii) Serial one-on-one conversations, whether formal
or informal, with members of a governing body by one or more members,
employees, agents, or informal representatives of the governing body to
discuss the governing body's business.
 (C) As used in this subdivision (10), "governing body"
includes without limitation the governing body of a municipality, county,
township, school district, board, bureau, commission, organization, school,
or other public entity that is subject to § 25-19-106;"
