Amendment No. 1 to Senate Bill 217

Amend Senate Bill No. 217 as originally introduced:

Page 7, delete lines 8 through 36, and substitute the following:

"SECTION. 6. Arkansas Code § 7-5-411(a)(2) and (3), concerning methods of voting by absentee ballot, are amended to read as follows:

(2) By delivery of the ballot to the county clerk of the county of residence of the voter not later than 7:30 p.m. on election day by <u>the</u> <u>voter or</u> the designated bearer, administrator, or the authorized agent of the absentee voter who is medically unable to vote at the regular polling site, upon proper verification of the signature of the voter by the county clerk and validation of the identity of the authorized agent; or

(3) The voter may deliver the ballot to the county clerk of the county of his or her residence not later than the close of regular business hours on the day before the election."
