## Amendment No. 1 to Senate Bill 501

Amend Senate Bill No. 501 as originally introduced:

Page 1, delete line 35, and substitute the following: "seq., as it existed on January 1, 2021.

SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 6-18-503(b)(3), concerning written student discipline policies, is amended to read as follows: (3) A school district that authorizes use of corporal punishment under subdivision (b)(1) of this section shall not: (A) Use corporal punishment on a child who is: (i) Is intellectually disabled, nonambulatory, nonverbal, or autistic; or (ii) Has an individualized education program in accordance with the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act, 20 U.S.C. § 1400 et seq., as it existed on January 1, 2021; or (B) Include in its written student discipline policy a provision to allow the use of corporal punishment on a child who is: (i) Is intellectually disabled, nonambulatory, nonverbal, or autistic; or (ii) Has an individualized education program in accordance with the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act, 20 U.S.C. § 1400 et seq., as it existed on January 1, 2021."
