Amend Senate Bill No. 567 as originally introduced:

Page 2, line 12, delete "report;" and substitute "report, including without limitation the coroner's case narrative;"

AND

Page 2, delete lines 15 and 16 and substitute the following: "(2) Except as provided under subsection (c) of this section, any other record shall be disclosed after the county"

AND

Page 2, delete lines 21 through 23 and substitute the following: "(ii) Address; and (iii) Phone <u>number;</u>"

AND

Page 2, line 27, delete "photographs;" and substitute "photographs; and"

AND

Page 2, line 29, delete "supervision;" and substitute "supervision."

AND

Page 2, delete lines 30 through 35 and substitute the following: "(c) The following records gathered or created during the course of a coroner's investigation shall be exempt from disclosure under the Freedom of Information Act of 1967, § 25-19-101 et seq.:

(1) Medical or psychiatric records provided to the coroner; and



(2) Laboratory reports related to the decedent generated based on the analysis of physical evidence if either the physical evidence or the report is discoverable under the Arkansas Rules of Criminal Procedure."

Page 3, line 1, delete "(c)" and substitute "(d)"
