Amendment No. 1 to Senate Bill 569

Amend Senate Bill No. 569 as originally introduced:

Page 1, line 24, delete "adrenal insufficiency or"

AND

Page 1, line 32, delete "adrenal insufficiency or"

AND

Page 1, delete line 35, and substitute the following: "(6) Treat low cortisol symptoms.

- SECTION 2. Arkansas Code Title 6, Chapter 18, Subchapter 7, is amended to add an additional section to read as follows:
- 6-18-717. Administration of medication and treatment for adrenal insufficiency.
- (a) Upon written request of a parent or guardian of a student with adrenal insufficiency and authorization by the treating physician of the student, the student in the classroom, in another area designated at the school, on school grounds, or at a school-related activity may:
- (1) Possess on his or her person the necessary supplies and equipment to perform adrenal insufficiency monitoring and treatment;
 - (2) Administer medication for adrenal insufficiency; and
 - (3) Treat low cortisol symptoms.
- (b) A student shall have access to a private area to perform adrenal insufficiency monitoring and treatment upon request of the parent or guardian of the student, as outlined in the student's health plan.
- (c) A public school employee may volunteer to be trained to administer and may administer hydrocortisone to a student with adrenal insufficiency in an emergency situation as permitted under § 17-87-103(11)."
