Amendment No. 1 to Senate Bill 574
Amend Senate Bill No. 574 as originally introduced:
Delete everything after the enacting clause and substitute the following:
"SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 27-19-107(a), concerning self-insured religious denomination organizations under the Motor Vehicle Safety Responsibility Act, is amended to read as follows:
(a) Any A person or religious denomination which may qualify as a
self-insurer by obtaining a certificate of self-insurance issued by the
Office of Motor Vehicle as described in subsection (b) of this section if:  (1) The person is someone in whose name more than twenty-five
(25) vehicles are registered in this state or any political subdivision or
municipality of this state, individually or collectively; or
(2) The religious denomination:
(A) has Has more than twenty-five (25) members who own
motor vehicles registered in this state and $\frac{\text{which}}{\text{that}}$ prohibits its members
from purchasing insurance of any form as being contrary to its religious
tenets, or any person in whose name more than twenty-five (25) vehicles are
registered in this state or any political subdivision or municipality of thi
state, individually or collectively, may qualify as a self-insurer by
obtaining a certificate of self-insurance issued by the Office of Motor Vehicle as provided in subsection (b) of this section; or
(B)(i) Shares liability among members for liability
insurance purposes.
(ii) The religious denomination described in
subdivision (a)(2)(B)(i) is considered an insurer for motor vehicle liabilit
insurance purposes."
