Subtitle of Senate Bill No. 589

CONCERNING THE MODIFICATION OF A CHILD CUSTODY OR VISITATION ORDER.

Amendment No. 1 to Senate Bill 589

Amend Senate Bill No. 589 as engrossed S4/1/21 (version: 04/01/2021 1:32:22 PM):

Page 1, delete lines 22 through 30, and substitute the following:

"(f)(1) Unless a child is in imminent danger of physical harm or living with a third party nonparent, a party shall not file a motion or countermotion to modify a child custody or visitation order if:

(A) The party requesting the modification has previously been ordered to pay and has or has had the ability to pay:

(i) Child support that has accrued unadjudicated arrears in an amount equal to or greater than twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000);

(ii) A judgment on child support arrears in an amount equal to or greater than twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) that is not ordered to be paid back in monthly installments; or

(iii) Attorney's fees and costs equal to or greater than twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) to another party in a previous child custody or visitation proceeding involving the child; and"

AND

Page 2, delete lines 11 through 15, and substitute the following:

"(A) The total outstanding balance and any accrued interest in full within five (5) business days; and

(B) An additional payment in the amount of twenty percent (20%) of the outstanding balance due at the time of filing of the motion or countermotion to modify the child custody or visitation order for attorney's fees and costs of participating in proceedings concerning the motion or countermotion to modify the child custody or visitation order."
