Page 4, delete lines 8 and 9, and substitute the following:
"available to the public upon request."

AND

Page 4, delete lines 14 through 16, and substitute the following:
"(B) Make the policies developed under subdivision (c)(2)(A) of this section available to the public upon request."

AND

Page 4, lines 34, delete "reported violation" and substitute "reported minor violation"

AND

Page 4, lines 35, delete "reported violation" and substitute "reported minor violation"

AND

Page 4, lines 36, delete "third violation" and substitute "third minor violation"

AND

Page 5, delete line 1, and substitute the following:
"subsequent minor violation;
(4) Disciplinary action for an illegal action or a major violation of the public entity's technology resources policy; and"



AND

Page 5, line 2, delete "(4)" and substitute "(5)"

AND

Page 5, delete line 26, and substitute the following:

"be deemed open public records under the Freedom of Information Act of 1967, § 25-19-101 et seq.

(i) The disciplinary policies under subsection (e) of this section shall not apply to employee communications made in compliance with the:

(1) Public Employees' Political Freedom Act of 1999, § 22-1-501 et seq.; or

(2) Arkansas Whistle-Blower Act, § 21-1-601 et seq."
