Amendment No. 1 to Senate Bill 189
Amend Senate Bill No. 189 as originally introduced:
Page 2, delete lines 17 through 32, and substitute the following:
"(vi) Intellectual disability, causing an impairment
of general function similar to that of persons with a developmental
disability, as established for an individual from:
(a) Birth to three (3) years of age, by a
score on an age-appropriate standardized assessment administered within the
past twelve (12) months that indicates a developmental delay of twenty-five
percent (25%) of the child's chronological age or greater in two (2) or more
of the following developmental domains:
(1) Cognitive;
(2) Communicative;
(3) Adaptive; (4) Social or emotional; and
(5) Physical;
(b) Three (3) to five (5) years of age, by a
score on an age-appropriate assessment administered within the past twelve
(12) months that indicates functioning on a level two (2) or more standard
deviations from the mean in two (2) or more areas; or
(c) Five (5) years of age and older, by a
full-scale standard intelligence score of seventy (70) or below, as measured
by a standard test designed for individual administration;"
