(3) A student who accompanies his or her parent when the parent is exercising his or her right to vote in a scheduled election is encouraged to demonstrate his or her attendance at the scheduled election by wearing an official sticker, badge, or other item that indicates he or she attended the scheduled election upon his or her return to school."
