Amend Senate Bill No. 318 as originally introduced:
Page 2, delete line 13, and substitute the following: "one (1) year, or both.
SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 20-25-105(a)(1), concerning the creation and members of the Arkansas Manufactured Home Commission, is amended to read as follows:
(a)(1) There is created the Arkansas Manufactured Home Commission consisting of ten (10) eight (8) members. Members shall be appointed by the Governor, to be and confirmed by the Senate, and appointments shall be made in such a manner as to result in at least one (1) member residing in each congressional district as the congressional districts now and hereafter
exist. The members shall be representative of the following interests: (A) Four (4) members shall be active in the manufactured
home industry <u>and licensed or certified under this chapter at the time of their appointment; and</u>
(B) Five (5) Four (4) members shall be from the public at large and shall not be employed by or retired from an entity licensed or certified under this chapter at the time of their appointment; and
(C) One (1) member shall be sixty (60) years of age or
older and represent the elderly. He or she shall not be actively engaged in
or retired from the manufactured home industry."
