AND

Page 2, line 33, delete "real or"

Page 3, line 8, delete "sale" and substitute "sales"

AND

Page 3, line 9, delete "real or"

AND

Page 4, line 7, delete "or"

AND

Page 4, line 8, delete "~~;-or~~" and substitute "; or"

AND

Page 4, delete lines 9 and 10, and substitute the following:

“(5) An auction conducted over the internet by means of a



website dedicated primarily to conducting auctions if:

(A) The person conducting the auction is licensed as a used motor vehicle dealer; and

(B) The property auctioned is within the scope of the license.”
