Page 4, line 8, delete "or" and substitute "or"

AND

Page 4, delete line 14, and substitute the following:

"license; or

(6) The owner of an e-commerce website or online marketplace that facilitates or provides consumer-to-consumer or business-to-consumer sales through the website or online marketplace and provides buyer and seller protections to the participants."

AND

Page 6, delete lines 20 and 21, and substitute the following:

"license shall entitle the board to collect a processing fee of five dollars (\$5.00) from the licensee."
