SECTION 4. Arkansas Code § 11-9-504(a), concerning additional compensation related to the injury to or death of an illegally employed minor resulting from Initiated Act 4 of 1948, is amended to read as follows:

(a) Where an injury or death is sustained by a minor employed in violation of federal or state statutes pertaining to minimum ages for employment of minors, including without limitation § 11-6-101 et seq., compensation or death benefits provided for by this chapter shall be doubled."
