TO CREATE THE PROTECTION OF MINORS FROM DISTRIBUTION OF HARMFUL MATERIAL ACT; TO
ESTABLISH LIABILITY FOR THE PUBLICATION OR DISTRIBUTION OF MATERIAL HARMFUL TO
MINORS ON THE INTERNET; AND TO REQUIRE REASONABLE AGE VERIFICATION.

Amendment No. 1 to Senate Bill 66

Amend Senate Bill No. 66 as originally introduced:

Add Senator J. Bryant as a cosponsor of the bill

AND

Add Representatives McAlindon, Bentley, K. Brown, C. Cooper, Crawford, Haak,
Long, Lundstrum, McGrew, Rose as cosponsors of the bill

AND

Page 4, delete lines 13 and 14, and substitute the following:

"(10) "Substantial portion" means more than thirty-three and
one-third percent (33.33%) of total material on a website that may be
material"

AND

Page 4, delete lines 27 through 35, and substitute the following:

"(b) Reasonable age verification methods under subsection (a) of this
section include providing:

(1) A digitized identification card, including a digital copy
of a driver's license under § 27-16-601 et seq.;

(2) Government-issued identification; or

(3) Any commercially reasonable age verification method."
