Page 5, delete lines 27 through 30, and substitute the following: "(g) The Arkansas Crime Information Center shall:

(1) Adopt and provide the following to be used by a petitioner and any circuit court in this state:

(A) A uniform petition for restoration of firearms rights;

and

(B) A uniform order to restore firearms rights; and (2) After receiving the notification required under (f)(2)(C) of CEB269 - 03-31-2025 05:31:44 Page 1 of 2 this section, notify the National Crime Information Center or its successor of the restoration of firearms rights."
