Amendment No. 1 to House Bill 1317

Amend House Bill 1317 as originally introduced:

Page 2, delete lines 19 through 23, and substitute the following:

"Any <u>A</u> person who knowingly makes any <u>a material</u> false statements <u>statement</u> or who <u>materially</u> falsifies or permits to be <u>materially</u> falsified any record in an attempt to defraud the Arkansas Public Employees' Retirement System as the result of such an act <u>upon conviction</u> shall be <u>is</u> guilty of a Class A misdemeanor Class D felony in accordance with § 5-55-301."

AND

Page 2, delete lines 27 through 31, and substitute the following:

"(a) Any <u>A</u> person who knowingly makes any <u>a material</u> false statements <u>statement</u> or who <u>materially</u> falsifies or permits to be <u>materially</u> falsified any records of the State Police Retirement System or the Division of Arkansas State Police in an attempt to defraud the system as the result of that act <u>upon conviction</u> shall be is guilty of a <u>misdemeanor</u> felony."

AND

Page 3, delete lines 2 through 5, and substitute the following: "<u>A person who knowingly makes a material false statement or who</u> <u>materially falsifies or permits to be materially falsified any record in an</u> <u>attempt to defraud the Arkansas Judicial Retirement System as the result of</u> LJH126 - 02-04-2025 10:19:40 Page 1 of 2 such an act upon conviction is guilty of a Class D felony in accordance with

<u>§ 5-55-301.</u>"
