(C) The commissioner may reduce the initial application fee under subdivision (c)(l) of this section or renewal application fee under subdivision (c)(2) of this section for a pharmacy benefits manager if the initial application fee or renewal application fee would constitute a financial hardship that would prevent a pharmacy benefits manager from doing business in this state or competing in the marketplace considering the limited number of Arkansas patients impacted or the limited type of pharmacy benefits manager services offered."

Page 6, delete lines 9 through 14, and substitute the following: "(f)(1) Except as provided in subdivision (f)(2) of this section, the information or data acquired during an examination under this section is: (A) Considered nonproprietary and confidential under § 23-61-107(a)(4) and § 23-61-207; and (B) Not subject to the Freedom of Information Act of 1967, § 25-19-101 et seq. (ii) The contracted pharmacy services administrative
