Page 3, line 36, delete "or a judgment"

Page 4, line 5, delete "or a judgment"

AND

Page 4, line 16, delete "member" and substitute "vested member"

AND

Page 4, line 17, delete "who begins making employee contributions" and substitute "whose rights have not yet vested in the system"

AND

Page 4, line 18, delete "following" and substitute "as of"
