Amendment No. 2 to Senate Bill 17

Amend Senate Bill 17 as engrossed S1/29/25 (version: 1/29/25 10:38:41 AM):

Page 1, delete lines 9 through 12, and substitute the following:

"AN ACT TO CREATE LUX'S LAW; TO PROHIBIT THE SALE OF A DEAD HUMAN BODY THAT IS INTENDED TO BE CREMATED OR BURIED; TO ESTABLISH PENALTIES FOR THE SALE OF A DEAD HUMAN BODY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

Delete the subtitle in its entirety and substitute the following:

"TO CREATE LUX'S LAW; TO PROHIBIT THE SALE OF A DEAD HUMAN BODY THAT IS INTENDED TO BE CREMATED OR BURIED; AND TO ESTABLISH PENALTIES FOR THE SALE OF A DEAD HUMAN BODY."

Page 1, delete lines 27 through 36, and substitute the following:
 "SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 5-60-101(a), concerning abuse of a corpse,
is amended to read as follows:

(a) A person commits abuse of a corpse if, except as authorized by law, he or she knowingly:

ANS237 - 02-11-2025 08:44:10

(1) Disinters, removes, dissects, or mutilates a corpse; or

(2) Sells a corpse, or any part of a corpse, after the corpse has been authorized for final disposition through cremation or burial; or

(2)(A)(3)(A) Physically mistreats or conceals a corpse in a manner offensive to a person of reasonable sensibilities.

(B) A person who conceals a corpse in a manner offensive to a person of reasonable sensibilities that results in the corpse remaining concealed is continuing in a course of conduct under § 5-1-109(e)(1)(B).

(C)(i) As used in this section, "in a manner offensive to a person of reasonable sensibilities" means in a manner that is outside the normal practices of handling or disposing of a corpse.

(ii) "In a manner offensive to a person of reasonable sensibilities" includes without limitation the dismembering, submerging, or burning of a corpse."
