TO ESTABLISH THE ARKANSAS PRIMARY CARE PAYMENT IMPROVEMENT WORKING GROUP.

Amendment No. 1 to Senate Bill 264

Amend Senate Bill 264 as originally introduced:

Page 2, delete lines 2 through 23, and substitute the following: "Working Group, to be composed of the following nine (9) members:

(1) The Secretary of the Department of Human Services, or his or her designee;

(2) The Insurance Commissioner, or his or her designee;

(3) A designee of the Arkansas Center for Health Improvement;

(4) A practicing primary care physician appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives;

(5) A representative of the Arkansas commercial health insurance community from an Arkansas-based insurer appointed by the Speaker of the <u>House of Representatives</u>;

(6) A pediatrician representative of the primary care community in this state appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives;

(7) A practicing primary care physician appointed by the President Pro Tempore of the Senate;

(8) An advanced practice registered nurse representative of the primary care community in this state appointed by the President Pro Tempore of the Senate; and

(9) A primary care physician employed by or primarily practicing in a federal qualified health center appointed by the President Pro Tempore of the Senate.

(b) The practicing primary care physician appointed by the President JMB548 - 03-17-2025 02:40:19 Page 1 of 2 <u>Pro Tempore of the Senate shall serve as Chair of the Arkansas Primary Care</u> <u>Payment Improvement Working Group and be responsible for scheduling regular</u> <u>meetings of the working group.</u>"
