I) AGENCY SUMMARY & REVENUE SOURCES

The Institution is located in Hope, Arkansas and had total student on-campus headcount of 1,164 (830 full-time equivalency) in the Fall, 2005. It is a two year institution of higher education, and became a part of the University of Arkansas System effective July 1, 1996. Hempstead County voters approved a 1/4% sales tax for support of the Community College.

TOTAL BIENNIAL BUGET

The Institution's total budget for the biennium is \$18.3 million the first year & \$18.4 million the second year.

FUNDING SOURCE

The budget is funded from 25.2% General Revenue, 9.8% Work Force 2000 funds, with the remaining 65% as cash funds from tuition, fees & federal funds.
