I) AGENCY SUMMARY & REVENUE SOURCES

MISSION

The Board was created by Act 1588 of 1999 and 1708 of 2001 to provide regulatory authority over persons who hold themselves out to the public as Licensed Alcoholism and Drug Abuse Counselors. The Board is responsible for establishing licensure and certification requirements, defining and promoting the practice of Alcoholism and Drug Abuse Counselors, setting the standards of qualifications, training, and experience for those who engage in the practice, and to maintain an office.

TOTAL BIENNIAL REQUEST

The executive recommendation of the 2009-11 biennium is \$25,113 for each year.

FUNDING SOURCE

The funding for this cash funded agency is derived from license fees generated for the operations of the Board.

II) SIGNIFICANT CHANGES

- The Operations appropriation, funded by Cash Funds, for \$25,113 each fiscal year provides for an additional \$1,300 each year in professional fees for increased mileage and compensation to the Board's Secretary.
