I) AGENCY SUMMARY & REVENUE SOURCES

MISSION

The Board oversees the practice of geology in the State by regulating the registration and certification of Geologists and promulgating and enforcing the regulations that provide the standards for practicing geology. The Board consists of seven members appointed by the Governor or set by the Act.

TOTAL BIENNIAL BUDGET

The total budget for the State Board of Registration for Professional Geologists is \$52,861 the first year and \$53,516 FY08 and \$56,588 FY09.

FUNDING SOURCE

The State Board of Registration for Professional Geologists is a cash agency funded from fees collected for registration, renewal, and penalties.

II) CHANGES/APPROPRIATIONS

The Board of Registration for Professional Geologists operates with one appropriation.

CASH OPERATIONS -

The biennial appropriation provides an increase of \$550 each year in operating expenses for increased costs in telecommunication, association dues, and network costs. An additional increase of \$2400 in the second fiscal year provides for computer replacement.
