**I) AGENCY SUMMARY & REVENUE SOURCES**

**MISSION**

The Board was created to regulate the practice of Psychology. The Board's two major functions are approving the credentials of applicants and then administering both written and oral examinations and the investigation of possible ethical violations or allegations of incompetent practice. The Board also is charged with implementing continuing education requirements.

**TOTAL BIENNIAL BUDGET**

The total budget is \$182,912 for the first fiscal year and \$184,620 for the second fiscal year.

**FUNDING SOURCE**

The Board of Examiners in Psychology is a cash fund agency. Fees are collected from licenses and examinations.

**II) CHANGES/APPROPRIATIONS**

The Operations appropriation will have \$3,500 reallocated each year from Professional Fees to Operating Expenses for increased postage and printing cost due to a larger number of licensees.
