

**ARKANSAS BEEF COUNCIL (302) - 2007-09 BIENNIUM
BUDGET INFORMATION ACCORDING TO ACT 37 of 2007**

I) AGENCY SUMMARY & REVENUE SOURCES

MISSION

The Beef Council's purpose is to administer a program of beef research, promotion and market development on behalf of the Arkansas cattle industry. The Council is made up of seven members appointed by the Governor.

TOTAL BIENNIAL BUDGET

The total budget of the 2007-09 Biennium is for \$1,100,000 each year.

FUNDING SOURCE

The Beef Council is funded entirely through special revenues collected from an assessment of \$1 per head on all cattle sold in Arkansas.

II) SIGNIFICANT CHANGE LEVEL REQUESTS

- The Beef Council Operations appropriation, funded by special revenues, for \$1,100,000 each fiscal year provides a continuation of Base Level.
