I) AGENCY SUMMARY & REVENUE SOURCES

The Institution is located in DeQueen, Arkansas and had total student on-campus headcount of 1,020 (718 full-time equivalency) in the Fall, 2005. It is a two year institution of higher education and became part of the University of Arkansas System effective July 1, 2001.

TOTAL BIENNIAL BUGET

The Institution's total budget for the biennium is \$19.7 million the first year & \$21.4 million the second year.

FUNDING SOURCE

The budget is funded from 18.8% General Revenue, 5.8% Work Force 2000 funds, with the remaining 75.4% as cash funds from tuition, fees & federal funds.
