I) AGENCY SUMMARY & REVENUE SOURCES

MISSION

The Commission is responsible for establishing minimum standards for selection and training of law enforcement officers in Arkansas. The Commission certifies officers according to certain training and education standards.

The Commission is committed to providing quality training to the law enforcement profession, utilizing the latest in law enforcement instructional methods, techniques and technology while emphasizing professional ethics and personal accountability.

TOTAL BIENNIAL BUDGET

Total appropriation is \$3,392,325 FY08 and \$3,417,945 FY09.

FUNDING SOURCE

Operations of the Commission are funded primarily from General Revenue with the remainder financed by Federal Funds and Cash Funds.

II) CHANGES/APPROPRIATIONS

Commission operates from three appropriations

- **LAW ENFORCEMENT STANDARDS - OPERATIONS.** Operating increases of \$54,000 FY08 and \$60,000 FY09 for building and ground maintenance, utility increases, rent, supplies, and food purchases. Capital Outlay increases of \$30,000 FY08 and \$12,500 FY09 for equipment.
- **DRUG DETENTION TRAINING - FEDERAL.** Base level appropriation only.
- **SPECIAL TRAINING - CASH.** DIVISION IS FUNDED FROM SPECIAL FEES COLLECTED FROM STATE AGENCIES FOR THE USE OF THE TRAINING ACADEMY FACILITIES. Base level appropriation only.
