I) AGENCY SUMMARY & REVENUE SOURCES MISSION

Arkansas Crime Information Center (ACIC) provides law enforcement with criminal records and criminal statistics through a computerized information system. ACIC administers the State's computerized Criminal History record system, the Sex and Child Offender Registry, and the Crime Victim Notification System.

TOTAL BIENNIAL BUDGET

The total operating budget is \$6,964,986 for FY08 and \$7,013,646 for FY09.

FUNDING SOURCE

ACIC is primarily funded from general revenues, with additional federal funding (12.6%) and special revenues (19%).

II) CHANGES/APPROPRIATIONS

- ACIC Operations Increase in Operating Expenses of \$173,280 each year for software expenses, fuel increases, and telecommunications costs. Capital Outlay increase of \$40,000 FY08 and \$30,000 FY09. Data Processing increases of \$62,200 each year and restoration of the Contingency Line Item of \$1,100,000.
- Statistical Analysis Professional fee increase of \$40,871 each year for a continuation of federal funding.
- Criminal History Improvement Project, Federal increase of \$18,286 each year.

III) ADDITIONAL POSITIONS.

IV) SPECIAL LANGUAGE

- Carry Forward provision of unexpended reimbursement monies for providing teleprocessing services to municipal, county, state and federal agencies.
- Use of Contingency Appropriation and Funding if federal funds are not available for the Computerized Criminal History Program or the JusticeXchange Program, contingency appropriation of \$1.1 million each FY may be used for regular salaries, personal services matching, maintenance,

and general operation line items.
