

ARKANSAS NORTHEASTERN COLLEGE (0180) - 2009-11 BIENNIUM

I) AGENCY SUMMARY & REVENUE SOURCES

The Institution is located in Blytheville, Arkansas and had total student on-campus headcount of 1,800 (1,183 full-time equivalency) in the Fall, 2007. It is a two year institution of higher education.

TOTAL BIENNIAL BUDGET

The Institution's total budget for the biennium is \$38.4 million the first year & \$38.7 million the second year.

FUNDING SOURCE

The budget is funded from 23% General Revenue, 2% Educational Excellence Trust Funds, 2% Work Force 2000 funds, with the remaining 74% as cash funds from tuition, fees & federal funds.

II) SIGNIFICANT CHANGES

Increase in Treasury appropriation of approx. \$344,000 million for FY10 and \$566,000 million for FY11.

Cash appropriations at FY2009 authorized level.
