**I) AGENCY SUMMARY & REVENUE SOURCES**

**MISSION**

The Arkansas Appraiser Licensing and Certification Board maintains a system for licensing and regulating state registered, licensed, and certified appraisers in Arkansas, assuring license holders have adequate education, experience and competency necessary to provide service consistent with their credentials. The board also investigates complaints concerning real estate appraisers in Arkansas.

**TOTAL BIENNIAL BUDGET**

The biennial budget for the board totals \$457,673 the first year and \$462,674 the second.

**FUNDING SOURCE**

The Appraiser Licensing Board is cash funded, with income generated from the receipt of application fees and annual license renewals.

**II) SIGNIFICANT CHANGES**

Regular Salaries and Matching of \$33,861 and \$11,438, respectively each year, for the continuation of one Supplemental Emergency Position approved during the current biennium. Increases in operating of \$6500 each year for travel, postage, and rent expenses. Travel increases of \$4000 each year for staff to attend necessary conferences.
