I) AGENCY SUMMARY & REVENUE SOURCES

MISSION

The Contract Licensing Board exists to preserve public health and safety in the construction industry in our state. Responsibilities include determining qualifications of applicants for contractor's licenses and authorizing the issuance of new and renewal licenses, investigating all alleged and factual violations of the Contractor's Licensing Law, the Contractor's Bond Law, and the Residential Licensing Law, as well as hold hearings and the assessment of penalties to ensure compliance.

TOTAL BIENNIAL BUDGET

The total agency budget request is \$2,360,220 the first year and \$2,382,695 the second year of the biennium.

FUNDING SOURCE

The Contractors Licensing Board is funded from the receipt of fees charged for examination, issuance, and renewal of commercial contractor's licenses and penalties associated with violations of regulations.

II) CHANGES/APPROPRIATIONS

CASH OPERATIONS-

Operating increases of \$22,000 each year for mileage and lodging expenses for investigators and postage. Capital Outlay increases of \$12,000 each year is for the replacement of outdated equipment. Capital Outlay of \$50,000 each year to fund various contractor apprenticeship programs throughout the state. New Line Item for \$150,000 each year entitled "Secondary Area Technical Centers - Construction Trades Training Grants" and \$300,000 each year for "Construction Industry Training Grants"
