I) AGENCY SUMMARY & REVENUE SOURCES

MISSION

The Arkansas Dietetics Licensing Board was established by Act 392 of 1989. The Board's functions to protect the health, safety and welfare of the public by providing for the licensing and regulation of persons engaged in the practice of dietetics. Statutory provisions for the Board may be found in A.C.A. 17-83-101 - 17-83-308. The Arkansas Dietetics Licensing Board is comprised of (7) members appointed by the Governor with the consent of the Senate for 5 year staggered terms.

TOTAL BIENNIAL BUDGET

The total budget of the 2009-11 Biennium is \$34,361 the first year and \$35,557 the second year.

FUNDING SOURCE

The board is funded by cash funds that are collected through application and license fees established in accordance with ACA § 17-83-203.

- The **Operations** appropriation, funded by Cash Funds, provides a total appropriation of \$34,361 the first year and \$35,557 the second year of the biennium with no significant change level requests.
