I) AGENCY SUMMARY & REVENUE SOURCES

MISSION

The Board was created to regulate the practice of Psychology. The Board's two major functions are approving the credentials of applicants and then administering both written and oral examinations and the investigation of possible ethical violations or allegations of incompetent practice. The Board also is charged with implementing continuing education requirements.

TOTAL BIENNIAL BUDGET

The total budget is \$189,120 for the first fiscal year and \$191,150 for the second fiscal year.

FUNDING SOURCE

The Board of Examiners in Psychology is a cash fund agency. Fees are collected from licenses and examinations.

II) CHANGES/APPROPRIATIONS

- Increase of \$591 appropriation in Operating Expenses each year for board member travel, increase in bank service charges and parking fees.
- Increase Professional Fees appropriation \$2,364 each year for increased cost of GL Suite Database - the management system used to keep records of licensees.
