I) AGENCY SUMMARY & REVENUE SOURCES

MISSION

The objectives of the Commission are to regulate and license new car manufacturers, manufacturers' representatives, dealers and salesmen.

TOTAL BIENNIAL BUDGET

The total appropriation for the first year is \$609,460 and \$600,165 for the second year of the biennium.

FUNDING SOURCE

The Arkansas Motor Vehicle Commission is Special Revenue agency derived from license fees, fines or penalties paid by automobile salesmen, dealers, manufactures and manufacturers representatives.

II) CHANGES/APPROPRIATIONS

- Increase of \$2,500 each year in order to hire a hearing officer to provide consistent services to the Agency.
- Provides \$34,000 in Capital Outlay in FY10 to replace 2 vehicles and \$17,000 in FY11 to replace one vehicle.

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IV) SPECIAL LANGUAGE

- Consumer Protection Allocation of \$17,500 each year in operating expenses for consumer protection efforts.
- Motor Vehicle Education and Training A fund transfer to the Department of Workforce Education Fund Account for expenses related to motor vehicle education and training. Funds transferred should not exceed \$150,000 in any one fiscal year.
