# SOYBEAN BOARD (329) - 2009-11 BIENNIUM

# I) AGENCY SUMMARY & REVENUE SOURCES

#### **MISSION**

The Soybean Promotion Board was created by Act 259 of 1971. The Board has the responsibility to plan and conduct a program of research, promotion and market development to foster the growth and development of the soybean industry. The Board consists of nine members appointed by the Governor.

#### TOTAL BIENNIAL BUDGET

The total budget of the 2009-11 biennium is \$8,101,000 each fiscal year.

#### FUNDING SOURCE

The board is funded entirely by special revenues resulting from an assessment of one-half of one percent of the net market value of soybeans sold in Arkansas.

### II) SIGNIFICANT CHANGES

- The Arkansas Soybean Board appropriation, funded by Special Revenues, provides a total appropriation of \$8,101,000 each fiscal year with change levels of:
  - 1. Operating Expenses increased by \$17,800 each fiscal year, of which \$2,000 each year is a reallocation from Professional Fees, to allow for increased administrative costs.
  - 2. Professional Fees decreased by \$2,000 each fiscal year and reallocated to Operating Expenses to properly classify expenses.
  - 3. Research & Development increased by \$3,675,200 each fiscal year to allow the Board to utilize increased revenues for additional research, development, and promotion projects.

# III) ADDITIONAL POSITIONS

Nine-member board appointed by the Governor with no authorized regular salary positions.
