I) AGENCY SUMMARY & REVENUE SOURCES MISSION

To provide a competently trained, educated, and retrainable workforce to support agriculture, business, health services, industry, and government.

The Technical Institutes serve the post-secondary educational needs of the community. Programs may include academic, occupational, cultural, vocational, and other courses and programs designed to meet the specific needs of industry and the community.

TOTAL BIENNIAL BUDGET

The total biennial appropriation request is approximately \$5.4 million for each year.

FUNDING SOURCE

Funding sources include approximately 56% General Revenue, 11% Cash funds from tuition and other income, 4% Federal funds, 12% as Workforce Education Grants, and 14% Workforce 2000 funds with the remainder as fund balance.

II) SIGNIFICANT CHANGES

*Operations - Increase of unfunded Salary and Matching appropriation of approximately \$30,400 each year for the restoration of a Maintenance Assist. pool position and an increase of \$75,000 in Extra Help appropriation and approximately \$4,200 in matching appropriation.

*Federal - Base Level

*Cash - Base level with an increase of \$300,000 each yr. in Capital Outlay to replace obsolete equipment.

IV) SPECIAL LANGUAGE

- Part-Time Faculty: State Contribution to state employee insurance trust fund not required on Part-Time Faculty positions.
- Additional Teaching Load provides additional pay for noncredit teaching assignments or for teaching courses beyond the defined teaching load and funded by private industry.
- Prohibits Department employees employed as Extra Help to exceed 85% of the maximum annual salary of a comparable position as authorized and not to exceed 1400 hours during any fiscal year.
