# I) AGENCY SUMMARY & REVENUE SOURCES MISSION

The Commission has sole jurisdiction over thoroughbred horse and greyhound dog racing. The Commission is authorized to grant franchises; approve racing dates; issue permits and licenses; hold hearings and take other action as necessary to supervise, regulate and effectively control the sport of racing in the State of Arkansas.

#### TOTAL BIENNIAL BUDGET

The total budget for the Racing Division is \$1,385,601 the first year and \$1,402,357 the second year of the biennium.

#### FUNDING SOURCE

The budget is funded from General Revenue (Miscellaneous Agencies Fund) and cash funds.

## II) CHANGES/APPROPRIATIONS

- 1. The operations appropriation, funded with general revenue for \$1,280,601 the first year and \$1,297,357 the second year of the biennium has no changes.
- 2. The cash appropriation, funded with cash for \$105,000 each fiscal year has no changes.

## IV) SPECIAL LANGUAGE

- 1. Extra Help Horse Racing: Authorizes a limited number of employees to work over 1,000 hours per year at specified hourly rates.
- 2. Extra Help Dog Racing: Authorizes a limited number of employees to work over 1,000 hours per year at specified hourly rates.
- 3. The DFA Director shall set a maximum number of racing passes to be printed and issued annually; the number shall not be less than the number printed in 1990.
