I) AGENCY SUMMARY & REVENUE SOURCES

MISSION

The Commission is responsible for establishing minimum standards for the selection and training of law enforcement officers in Arkansas. The Commission provides basic training for new officers and specialized training for certified police officers at the ALETA training academy near East Camden, while also providing field training classes across the state.

TOTAL BIENNIAL BUDGET

Total biennial budget is \$3,607,140 the first year and \$3,656,074 the second.

FUNDING SOURCE

Operations of the Commission are funded primarily from General Revenue with the remainder financed by federal grants and cash funds.

II) CHANGES/APPROPRIATIONS

Commission operates from three appropriations

- **LAW ENFORCEMENT STANDARDS - OPERATIONS.** Base Level and unfunded appropriation of \$12,500 each year in capital outlay for sales tax on new vehicle purchases. Funding from General Revenues of \$3,148,367 FY10 and \$3,197,301 FY11.
- **DRUG DETENTION TRAINING - FEDERAL.** Operating expenses of \$45,773 each year and conference and travel of \$500 each year in anticipation of receiving federal grant funds for Drug Detection Training.
- **SPECIAL TRAINING - CASH.** DIVISION IS FUNDED FROM SPECIAL FEES COLLECTED FROM STATE AGENCIES FOR THE USE OF THE TRAINING ACADEMY FACILITIES. Base level and capital outlay of \$31,325 each year for the purchase of kitchen equipment..
