I) AGENCY SUMMARY & REVENUE SOURCES

Mission

The Arkansas Court of Appeals was established by the General Assembly pursuant to the provisions of Amendment 58 to the Arkansas Constitution to help alleviate the tremendous caseload of the Arkansas Supreme Court. The Court of Appeals is composed of a total of twelve judges. The state is divided into four districts and three Court of Appeals Judges represent each district.

Total Appropriation

The total appropriation for fiscal year 2011 is \$4.1 million.

The Court of Appeals is funded by the State Central Services Fund.
