I) AGENCY SUMMARY & REVENUE SOURCES

Mission

The Office of the Prosecutor Coordinator (PCO) was created in 1975 by Act 925, A.C.A. 16-21-201. The Prosecution Coordination Commission sets the overall policy of the Coordinator's Office. The office provides a broad range of technical assistance and support services for prosecuting attorneys, their deputies, and support staff. The PCO has the following main program areas: Legal Research, Continuing Legal Education, Lending Library, Publications, Civil Commitments, Victim/Witness, and Computers.

Total Appropriation

The total appropriation for fiscal year 2011 is \$1,016,662.

Funding Source

The Office of Prosecutor Coordinator operations appropriation is funded with the State Central Services Fund and a fund transfer from the Special State Asset Forfeiture Fund for one Attorney position for Drug Law Enforcement. The Office also receives transfers from the State Administration of Justice Fund for the Law Enforcement and Prosecutorial Programs appropriation.
