**Mission**

The Supreme Court exercises appellate jurisdiction, coextensive with the state, and has general superintending control over all inferior courts of law and equity. The Supreme Court also has the authority to regulate the practice of law and the professional conduct of attorneys and to determine the appellate jurisdiction of the Court of Appeals. The Supreme Court is composed of one Chief Justice and six Associate Justices.

**Total Appropriation**

The total appropriation for fiscal year 2011 is \$4.1 million.

**Funding Source**

Funding for the operations of the Supreme Court is from the State Central Services Fund.
