## I) AGENCY SUMMARY & REVENUE SOURCES Mission

The Office of Auditor of State is a constitutionally created office with the statutory responsibility to act as the general accountant of the state. The Auditor's responsibilities include issuance of all warrants drawn from the State Treasury and keeping an account of each state agency. The Auditor also serves as the custodian for Unclaimed Property.

The Operations appropriation for fiscal year 2011 is \$2,616,293. The Unclaimed Property operations appropriation for fiscal year 2011 is \$1,141,050.
