

ARKANSAS MANUFACTURED HOME COMMISSION (305) - FISCAL YEAR 2011

I) AGENCY SUMMARY & REVENUE SOURCES

MISSION

The Commission is to enforce the Federal Manufactured Home Construction and Safety Standards and the Federal Manufactured Home Procedural and Enforcement Regulations. The Commission regulates by requiring manufacturers and dealers to be certified with the Commission and installers and salespersons to be licensed with the Commission. The Commission is also charged with monitoring manufactured home dealer lots and to act as a consumer protection agency which handles consumer complaints relating to structural defects in the home and the blocking or anchoring of manufactured homes.

TOTAL APPROPRIATION

The total appropriation for Fiscal Year 2011 is \$560,297. Of the total appropriation, \$220,000 is for reimbursements paid for repairs for qualified homeowners and refunds.

FUNDING SOURCE

The Commission is funded through Special & Federal Revenues from fees charged to dealers, manufactures, and installers.
